NorCal State Cup:

- Center referees signed up for NorCal State Cup games must check with the Director of Referees what special procedures (independent series of 5 penalty kicks, extra time, kicks from the penalty mark etc.) are required for your game well before the day of the game.

Never:

- Allow casts, jewelry, non-prescription glasses, hard brimmed hats or caps
- Allow anything which is, in your opinion, dangerous to either the player or to others
- Issue a red or yellow card to a U8 or U10 recreational player

Additional Time:

- A small amount of additional time may be added to competitive (class 1 & class 3) games at the discretion of the referee.
- Additional time is not to be added to recreational (class 4) games. Always allow time for a penalty kick to be taken.

Sportsmanship Rule:

- It is WCCYSL policy for **recreational** games that once the score differential is 5 goals, the winning coach has the responsibility to make adjustments to help prevent the differential from increasing. Referees should remind the coach of this policy anytime when the goal differential becomes 5 and each time it increases above 5.

Substitutions:

Normal substitutions are at the following times at the discretion of the referee:

- Throw-In (only for team taking throw-in)
- Goal Kick / After a Goal / Half Time / Quarter Break (either team)
- After play stopped for injury (either team)
- After play stopped for caution (cautioned player only, at coach's discretion)

Minimum Number of Players:

- The minimum number of players for an 11 v 11 game is 7.
- The minimum number of players for a 7 v 7 or 8 v 8 game is 5.
- All minimums include the mandatory goalkeeper.

Send-Offs:

- You **MUST** inform the Director of Referees about ALL send-offs (involving players, coaches and/or spectators) before the end of the day in which the sendoff(s) occurred.

Game Levels:

Refscheduler.net shows games levels in the division column. Levels are of the form Unnxc where nn is the age group, x is the gender and c is the class of play. For example U16G3 is an under 16 girls class 3 game. For class 1 a "-N" suffix is used to denote a NorCal League game and "-C" to denote a NorCal State Cup Game. So a U11B1-N game is an under 11 boys class 1 NorCal League game, and U9G1-C is an under 9 girls class 1 NorCal State Cup game. No suffix on a class 1 game denotes it as a GSSL game.

Referee Pay:

The following fee structure table applies to regular WCCYSL-hosted games:

- If any organizing league (D4, GSSL or NorCal) dictates a specific fee, or pays a specific fee (either directly or indirectly) for their games then their fee levels will be used instead.
- If any organizing league (D4, GSSL or NorCal) provides and pays referees (via the Neutral Referee Program, for example) then that league will do so according to its own fee structure.
